Bull and First Breeding Season Guarantee:

We guarantee the fertility status on all our bulls.

All bulls are guaranteed to be sound breeders for the first breeding season unless injury is caused by the buyer's negligence or an act of God. (Breeding season is defined as the 90-day period following the first turnout of the bulls). If a bull needs to be replaced the buyer gets a 50% credit minus salvage value at the next year's sale, a replacement if one is available, or 50% of your money back minus salvage value. The guarantee does not cover death of the bull or any treatable condition such as foot rot or pink eye. Please notify us as soon as possible should an injury occur, and prior to the bull being sold for salvage.

Delivery:

Bull delivery within the state of Montana is free.

We will work with out of state buyers to arrange delivery. Let us know at check out when the best time to deliver the bulls will be. A \$50 discount will be given for bulls picked up on sale day.

About our cattle . . .

After calving, our pairs spend the Spring and Summer on pasture near Hobson and North of Moccasin. Our calves are raised with NO creep feed.

After a summer of severe drought, all our bulls were weaned September 1st and put on feed. They are fed by Jeremy Grove at his facility near Moccasin. They are on a high roughage ration and on average gained 3.71 lb per day between weaning and yearling weight. They were vaccinated at branding and weaning with Vista 1, Vision 7 Somubac and Ultrabac. The bulls were fertility tested on March 1st and were poured again.

At weaning on September 15, our heifer calves averaged 614 lbs. They wintered very well and are ready to set up for mid April AI breeding.

Over the past decade we have intensively selected and culled our mother cows for phenotype, performance, mothering ability and disposition. We are pleased with the results of our program as we continue to move our Angus herd forward to provide the best possible genetics not only for our program but for improving our customer's cattle herds.



How to read the information printed with each sale lot

Expected Progeny Difference (EPD), is the prediction of how future progeny of each animal are expected to perform relative to the progeny of other animals listed in the database. EPDs are expressed in units of measure for the trait.

GROWTH EPDs:

Calving Ease Direct (CED), is expressed as a difference in percentage of unassisted births, with a higher value indicating greater calving ease in first calf heifers. It predicts the average difference in ease with which a sire's calves will be born when he is bred to first-calf heifers.

Birth Weight EPD (BW), expressed in pounds, is a predictor of a sire's ability to transmit birth weight to his progeny compared to that of other sires.

Weaning Weight (WW) & Yearling Weight (YW), expressed in pounds, is a predictor of a sire's ability to transmit weaning & yearling growth to his progeny compared to that of other sires.

Scrotal Circumference EPD (SC), expressed in centimeters, is a predictor of the difference in transmitting ability for scrotal size compared to that of other sires.

MATERNAL EPD:

Milk EPD (Milk), is a predictor of a sire's genetic merit for milk and mothering ability as expressed in his daughters compared to daughters of other sires. In other words, it is that part of a calf's weaning weight attributed to milk and mothering ability.

EPD Percentile Ranking

Angus breed comparison of EPDs to other non-parent bulls.

CARCASS EPDs:

Carcass Weight EPD (CW), expressed in pounds is a predictor of the differences in hot carcass weight of a sire's progeny compared to progeny of other sires.

Marbling EPD (Marb), expressed as a fraction of the difference in USDA marbling score of a sire's progeny compared to progeny of other sires.

Ribeye Area EPD (RE), expressed in square inches, is a predictor of the difference in ribeye area of a sire's progeny compared to progeny of other sires.

Multi-trait selection indexes to assist beef producers by adding simplicity to genetic selection decisions. **\$Values are reported in dollars per head.** The \$Value is an estimate of how future progeny of each sire are expected to perform, on average, compared to progeny of other sires in the database if the sires were randomly mated to cows and if calves were exposed to the same environment.

Weaned Calf Value (\$W), is the expected average difference in future progeny performance for preweaning merit. \$W includes both revenue and cost adjustments associated with differences in birth weight, weaning direct growth, maternal milk, and mature cow size.

Beef Value (\$B), is the expected average difference in future progeny performance for postweaning and carcass value compared to progeny of other sires.
