## **HAGUE ANGUS RANCH HISTORY**

If it interests you, keep reading for a little history of the ranch and my roots as a cow calf producer in western Nebraska.

The name Hague comes from the original settler of the land during the Homestead Act that we are now on. There is not a lot of information about him, other than his name was Hague and the Peterson brothers, my Great Grandpa and Uncles, acquired the land in the early 1920's.

The Peterson brothers split the 100,000 acres into four individual places. The land that Gust and Flossie (Great Grandparents) got was comprised of the Miles, the Gentle, the Kickin', and the Hague. My grandma had a sister that led to another split of the land. Martha and John (grandparents) got the Kickin' and the Hague; her sister and family got the Gentle and the Miles.

My grandpa John and Dad incorporated, forming 9 Over 9 Cattle Company in the 80's which came fully under my dad's control in 1985. Half of that is now Hague Angus Ranch.

The Hague Ranch has been around for even longer than the Peterson's and my family in the Sandhills. We were just fortunate and blessed to have acquired it many years ago. Grandpa through the 1960's and 1970's had Hereford's. Dad introduced Red Angus and Simmental in the 70's (my dad got good at pulling calves). After doing percentage cattle for a number of years, my dad bought his first Angus bull in 1986. We haven't turned back since.

Luckily my dad did not follow the fads too much, and didn't get caught up in the numbers and growth. A lot of milk and growth made sense when you calved in January and fed your cows every day with a mixer wagon. My dad saw the light though and started moving calving dates back to late March and feeding the cows out on range. When he started pulling the groceries, he saw more opens, mastitis, and overall problems. He knew his cows got too big and had too much milk, which is when he took his first step in the right direction and visited Tim Ohlde.

That was in 1998. He knocked out some frame and added efficiency from 1999 to 2007. Well, that is when I got back to the ranch from college and wanted to take things even further down the low input grass genetic road. I have maintained the body type that my dad proved to work. All I did was fine tune the genetics and bring registered cattle into the operation, but believe me, papers never changed the way we run them. And there still ain't a bit of sympathy for the ones that aren't working for us!

In recent years, my brother and I, along with our families and on good terms, have divided the ranch that Dad and Mom took over from my grandparents. Dad, Justin, and I are the only remaining family members on the land from the original 100,000 acre – four Peterson brothers ranches. All this history has led to the formation and creation of Hague Angus Ranch. I am a 5th generation rancher on this place and hopefully, with God's direction and grace – will continue on through my kids as the next generation.

### "Raised in Our Environment to Thrive in Yours"



Raised in our Environment to Thrive in Yours is not just a catch phrase, it is a reality. At the ranch we have a no mercy policy that resembles that of a low input commercial cow calf producer, rather than that of a typical seed stock producer.

We are commercial cowmen and treat everything here as so. Longevity is the single most profitable trait in cow calf operations, but most leading bulls in the country or the major stud catalogs are out of cows that have only had 4 or 5 calves or less. The matriarch dams at Hague Angus like 912, 708, 443, etc. stuck around until they were 14 or more years.

Our environment sorts for us, and not a computer generated program full of algorithms. Cattle here are not fed up and flashy, but hardy and built to last. There aren't any silage piles or ethanol plants around our place. So why on earth would I rely on that for a long-term feed source?

We are just shy of 4000ft elevation with a 10-12 inch rainfall average. However, from 2002 through 2012 we averaged 5.2 inches of rain. Another downfall here is getting trees to grow. There are Zero trees on our place except for the homestead locations. We get 105 in the summer and can have wind chills as low as 60 below. The girls stay out on pasture year-round being fed Rio Nutrition mineral tubs, Hay and fresh water.

We believe in the hidden values of beef production. While most worry about how much their calves weigh, I care far greater for Longevity, fertility, Feet, Structure, Environmental adaptability, and efficiency. We live in an area that takes about 26 acres to run a cow. Our hills are made up of very fine blow sand and high alkaline ph, which leads to poor quality forage. The land here is very fragile and moves quick in a steady wind causing erosion very fast.

The good Lord blessed us with this little corner of the earth and we will continue to operate it and improve the things we can control. Which are heal the land, make hardy adaptable Angus cattle, and serve you as our customer to increase your success and simplify your life in the process.
