HOW THIS SALE CLOSE WORKS

The online auction will close with horse race style bidding or extended bidding. This means that when the online auction event comes to its scheduled end time there will be 5 more minutes of extended bidding. If bidding continues the sale will stay open until there is a 5-minute stretch with no bidding on any lot. Once there is a full 5 minutes with no bidding on any lot, the whole event will close.

This auction is scheduled to close at 7pm on May 11th, 2022.

Example 1: The auction closes at 7pm and goes into extended bidding. If there are no bids on any lot between 1pm and 1:05pm. The whole sale is declared closed at 7:05pm.

Example 2: The Auction is scheduled to close at 1pm and goes into extended bidding. There is a bid on a lot at 7:02pm. Every lot remains open to bids. If there are no bids on any lot by 7:07, the whole sale is declared closed at 7:07pm.

Example 3: The Auction is scheduled to close at 7pm and goes into extended bidding. There is a bid on a lot at 7:02pm. Every lot remains open to bids. Another bid is placed at 7:06. Every lot remains open. Another bid is placed at 7:10. Every lot remains open. If there are no bids on any lot by 7:15, the whole auction is declared closed at 7:15pm.

You may use the maximum bidding feature throughout the extended bidding. A maximum bid will automatically increase your bid when someone else bids on this lot up to your set maximum.

If you are the highest bidder, or want to be, and the auction is coming to a close keep an eye on your Watchlist. During the bidding process you will not need to refresh your page to ensure you are viewing the most current bidding activity. The auction platform auto-refreshes the page, and the bidding is in real time.

North Fork Angus began growing a registered Angus herd in 2001 with several starter cows that we purchased from a good friend, mentor and neighbor, Ede Brietmiere – a highly regarded breeder of Black Angus Cattle. Over the past 18 years we have slowly grown our herd to 120 registered black Angus cows with a strong emphasis placed on the mother cow. Having a relatively small herd requires us to focus our sire selection that will help maintain the ideals we expect from moderate-sized, highly productive cows. Our herd sire selection is centered around proven females that demonstrate longevity, solid foot structure, functional udders, mothering ability and fertility. We strive to maintain consistency in our breeding program which in turn has produced a consistently sized cow herd with no surprises. Our ranch is in the Milk River Valley along the hi-line in North Central Montana, as well as north, closer to the Canadian border. Our cattle thrive despite harsh weather changes, a shorter growing season, and relatively long winters.
